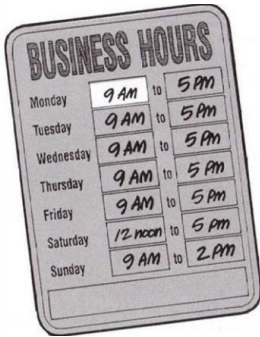




Part 6a: Creating Language using Basic Vocabulary

Question 1: This is a sign on a door. What time does the store open on a Monday?



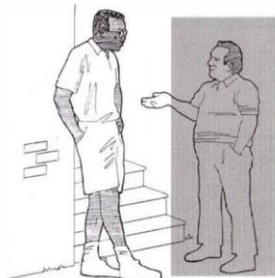
